## Schizophrenia DSM-V Diagnostic Criteria

- $\geq$  2 symptoms present for period of 1 month or more:
  - Delusions\*
  - Hallucinations\*
  - Disorganized speech (frequent, derailment or incoherent)\*
  - Disorganized behavior
  - Negative symptoms (affective flattening, alogia, or avolition)

\* 1 symptom must include hallucinations, delusions, or disorganized speech

- Causes significant disturbance in one's life (e.g. social and/or occupational dysfunction)
- Symptoms present for ≥6 months
- Rule out other mental heath diagnoses medical causes, substance use
